Technical Appendix

This appendix reports the demographic breakdown and Brexit vote patterns among the different subsamples across each wave of the Beyond Us and Them survey series 2020-2021. Note that not all details were measured in every wave. For comparative purposes we also report the relevant data from the preceding UK Census.

The survey series included 16 sub-surveys to reach specific populations as follows:

- a) Kent, Scotland and Wales (target N = 500 in each), measured in all 8 waves, recruited initially via Qualtrics Panels and topped up subsequently via Prolific Academic;
- b) Social cohesion investment areas, specifically the 5 'Integration investment' local authorities of Blackburn with Darwen, Bradford, Peterborough, Walsall, Waltham Forest, and a 6th local authority, Calderdale, which also had implemented a specific social cohesion investment strategy (target N = 200 from each). Initially recruited via local authorities, (though in Peterborough via Qualtrics Panels), and sample sizes sustained thereafter with additional recruitment via Prolific in the later waves. The local authority data were collected in Waves 2, 4, 6, 7, and 8;
- c) Community activists recruited through the partnership network of Belong the Cohesion and Integration Network (initial target 1000 from Wave 2), but subsequently combined with respondents who self-identified as community activists within other samples.
- d) Metropolitan areas. Qualtrics Panels established samples in the following metropolitan areas in Wave 6: Greater Manchester Combined Authority (GMCA, N = 1000), West Midlands Combined Authority (WMCA, N = 1000), West of England Combined Authority (WMCA, N = 500), and Greater London Authority (GLA, N = 2000). The sample sizes were determined to correspond to differences in the sizes of populations in the 4 areas whilst also sustaining sufficient statistical power. These samples continued into waves 7 and 8.
- e) Boost samples of Black and Muslim respondents drawn from the metropolitan areas in order to achieve N of at least 500 each in Waves 6, 7 and 8.

These samples were retained longitudinally as far as possible, and new contacts were recruited at each wave to sustain the overall sample sizes.

For Scotland ethnicity and all disability statistics, age interval starts from 16. For all other variables in Census data the starting age is 18. Physical and mental disability were not reported separately in Census data. Brexit vote statistics were not available to capture the whole of WECA or GMCA. Therefore, Brexit vote for WECA was estimated by calculating weighted averages for South Gloucestershire, Bath and North Somerset, and Bristol, as these were the three areas from which respondents were recruited. For GMCA the population Brexit vote was calculated using the sum of the votes for all constituent authorities (Bolton, Bury, Manchester, Oldham, Rochdale, Salford, Stockport, Thameside, Trafford and Wigan). Educational qualification statistics are coded with values of 1,2,3,4 and 5 which correspond, respectively, to entry level, Level 1,2,3 and 4 in official qualification levels (https://www.gov.uk/what-different-qualification-levels-mean/list-of-qualification-levels)
