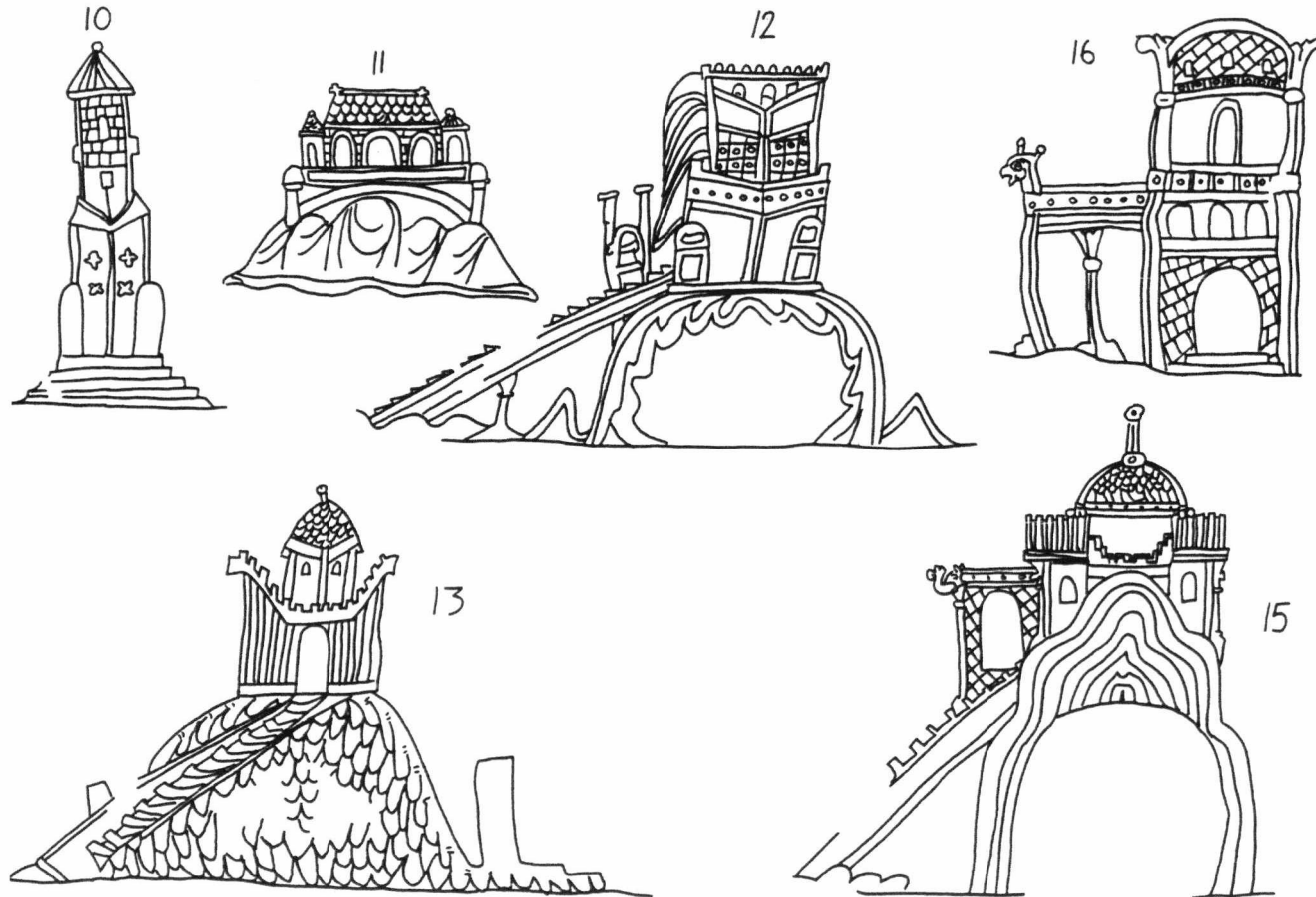
Appendix Illustration: Tapestry Buildings 1, 2, 3 and 4



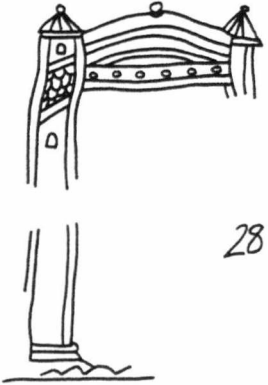
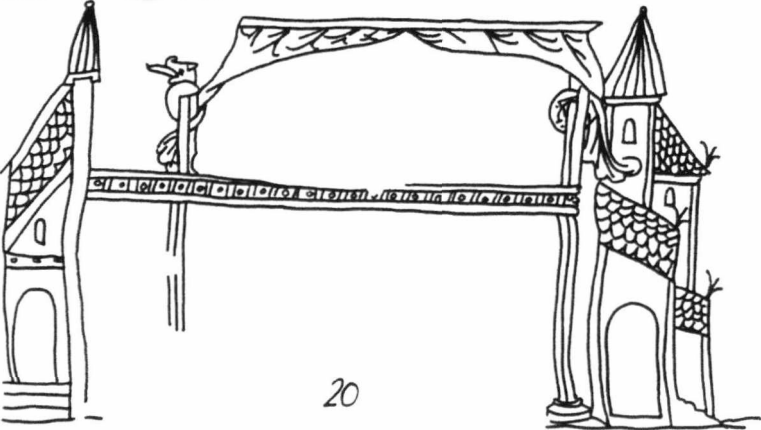
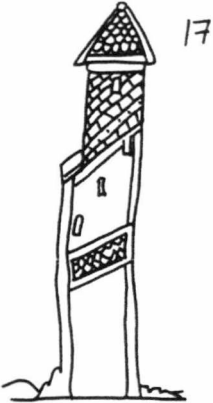
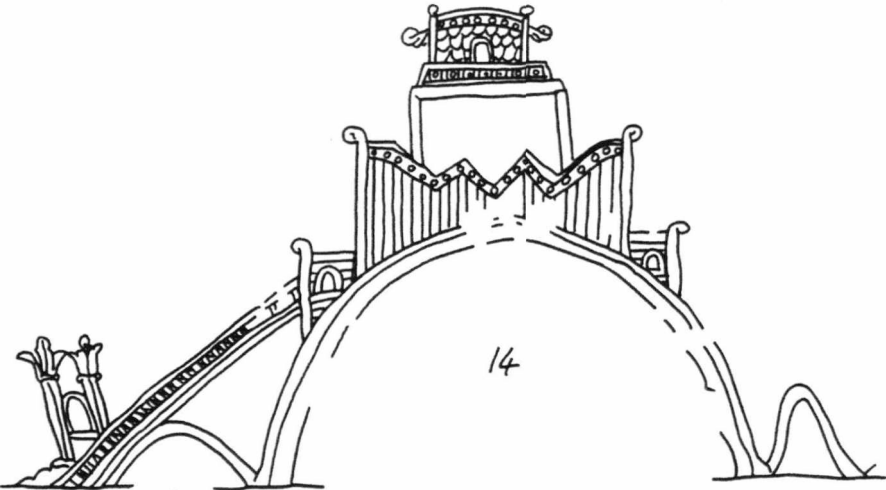
Appendix Illustration: Tapestry Buildings 5, 6, 7, 8 and 9



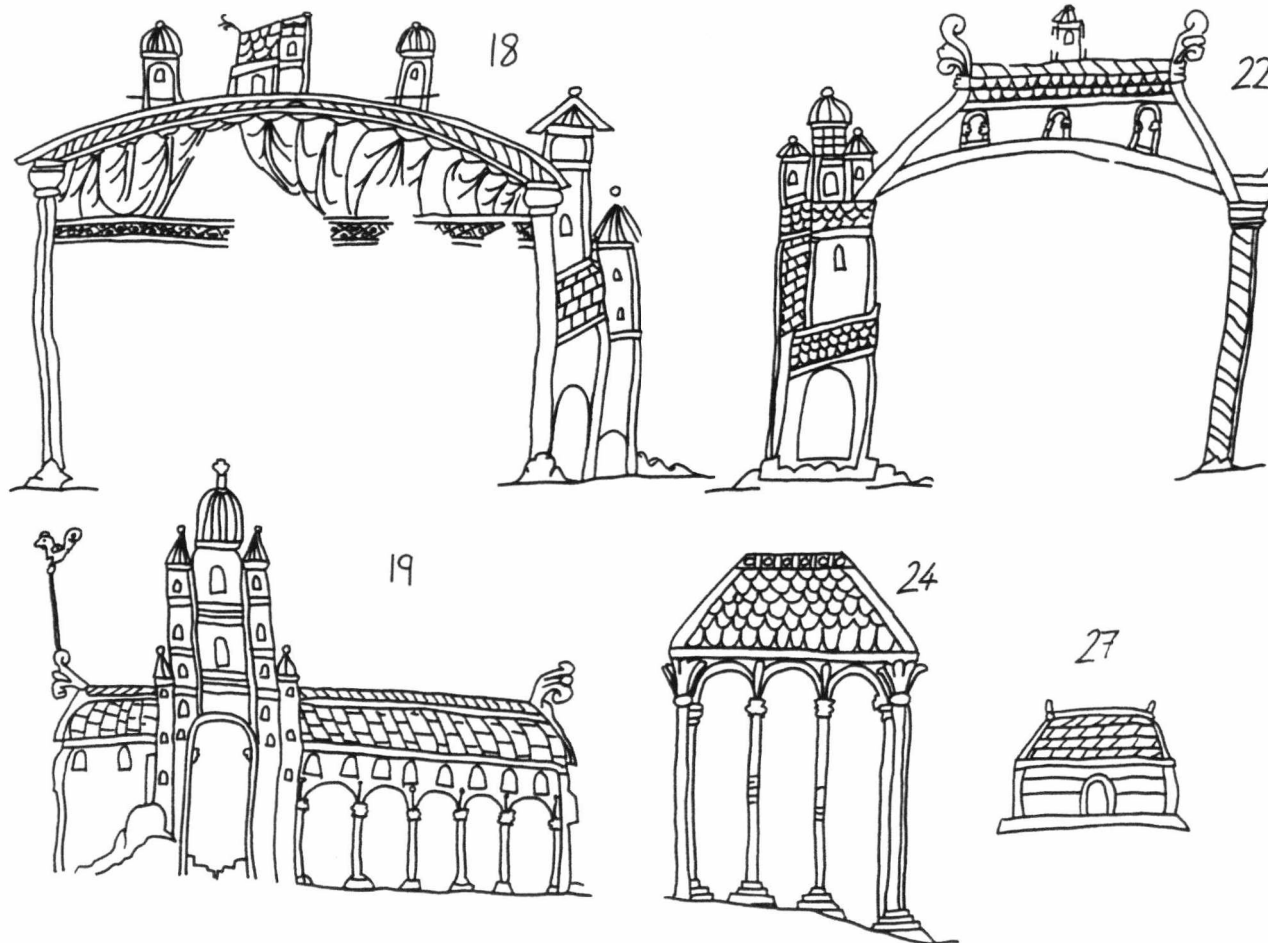
Appendix Illustration: Tapestry Buildings 10, 11, 12, 13, 15 and 16



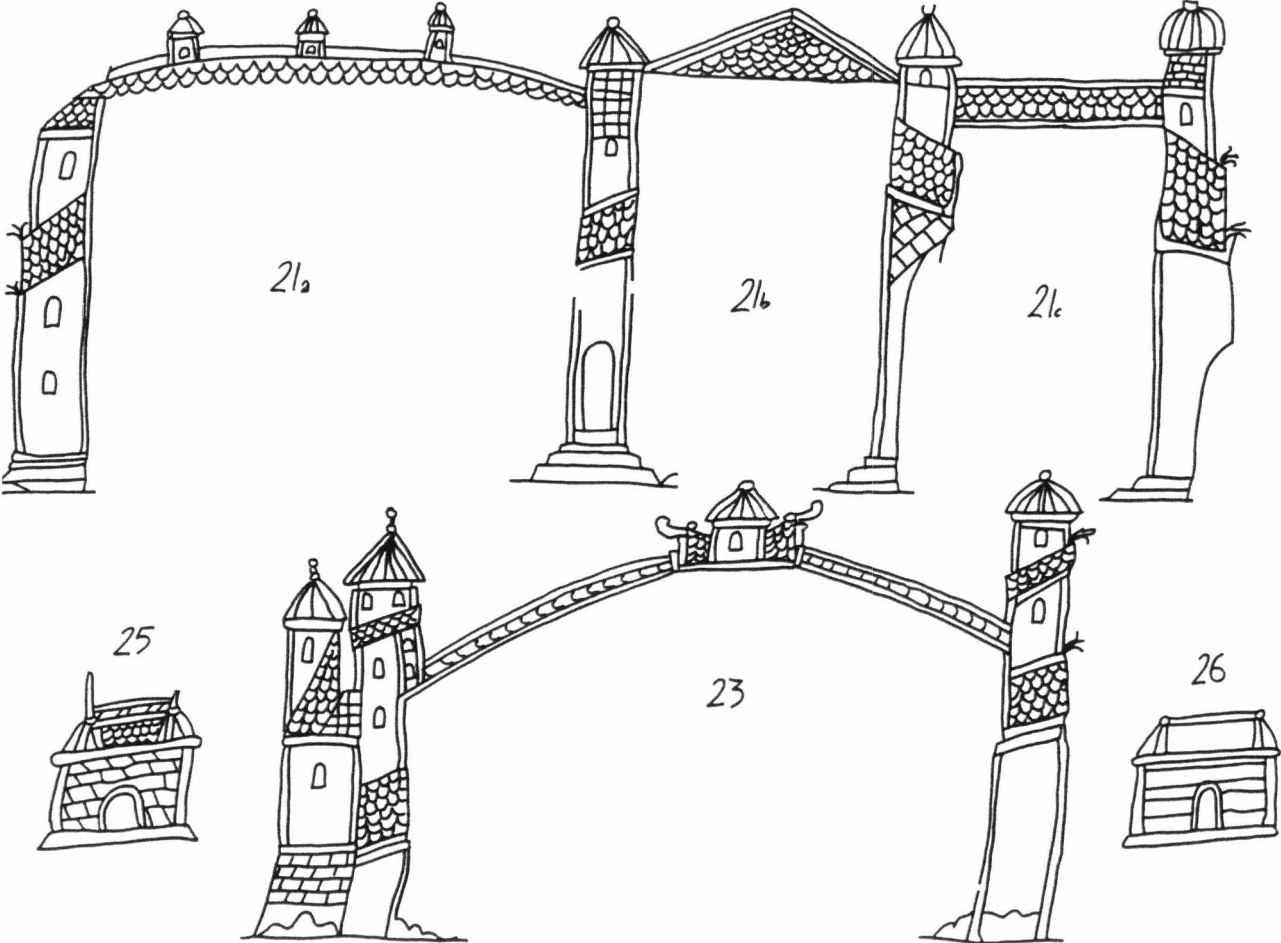
Appendix Illustration: Tapestry Buildings 14, 17, 20 and 28



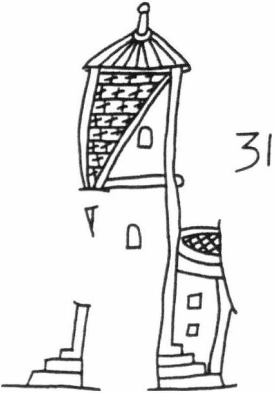
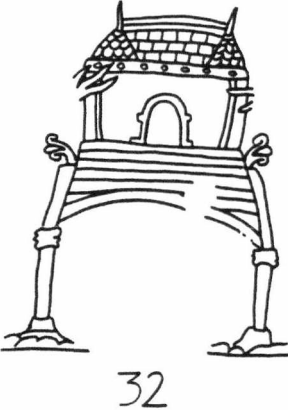
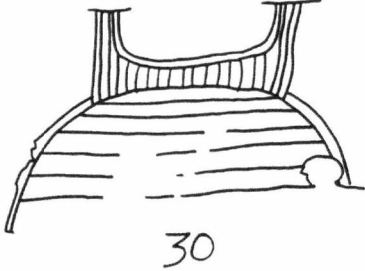
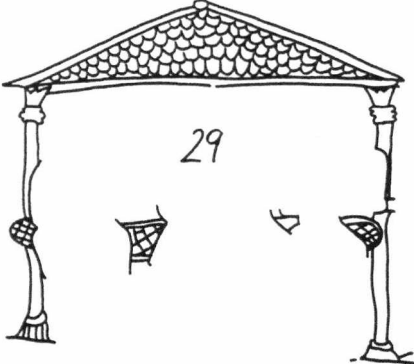
Appendix Illustration: Tapestry Buildings 18, 19, 22, 24 and 27



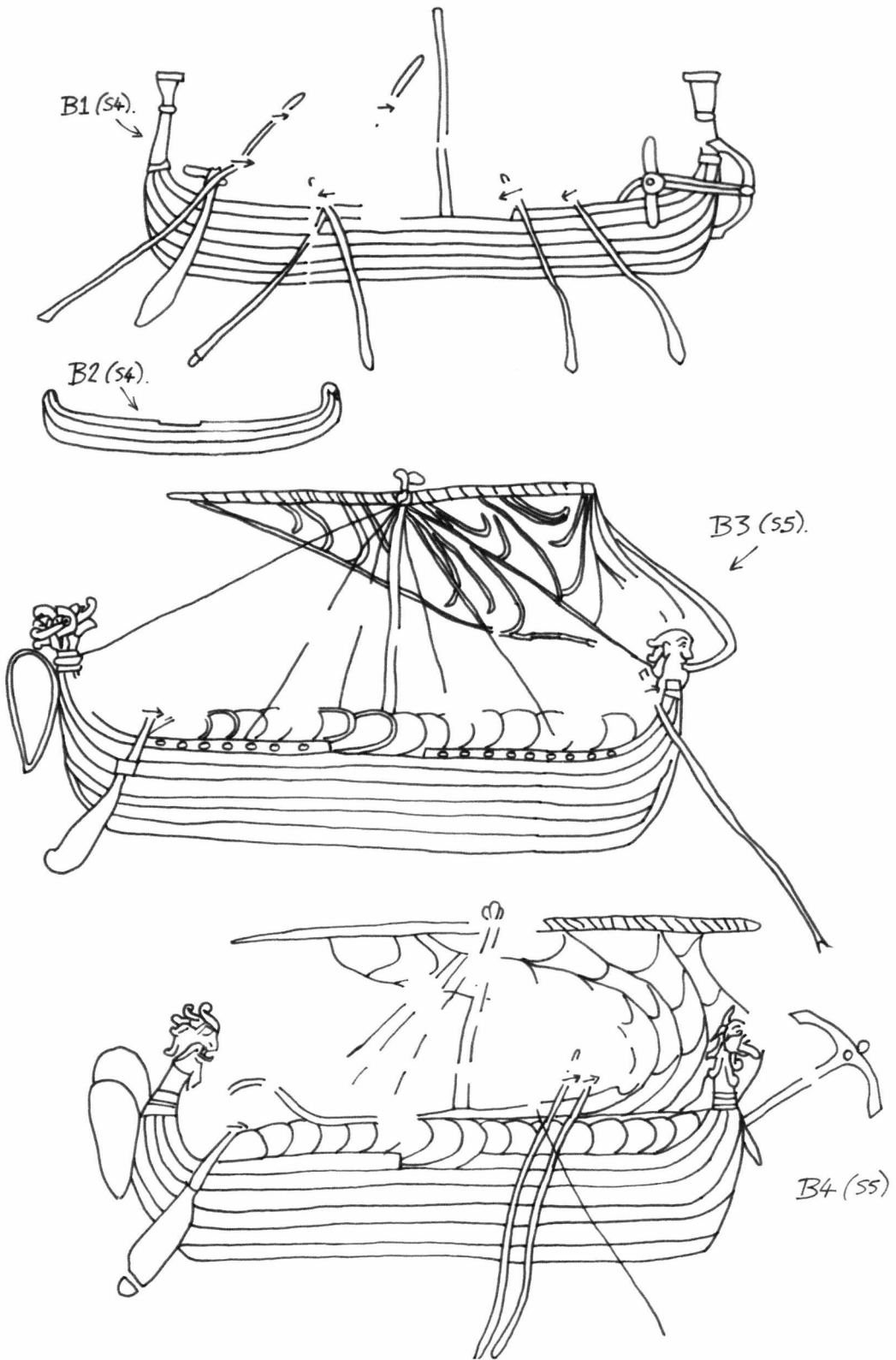
Appendix Illustration: Tapestry Buildings 21, 23, 25 and 26



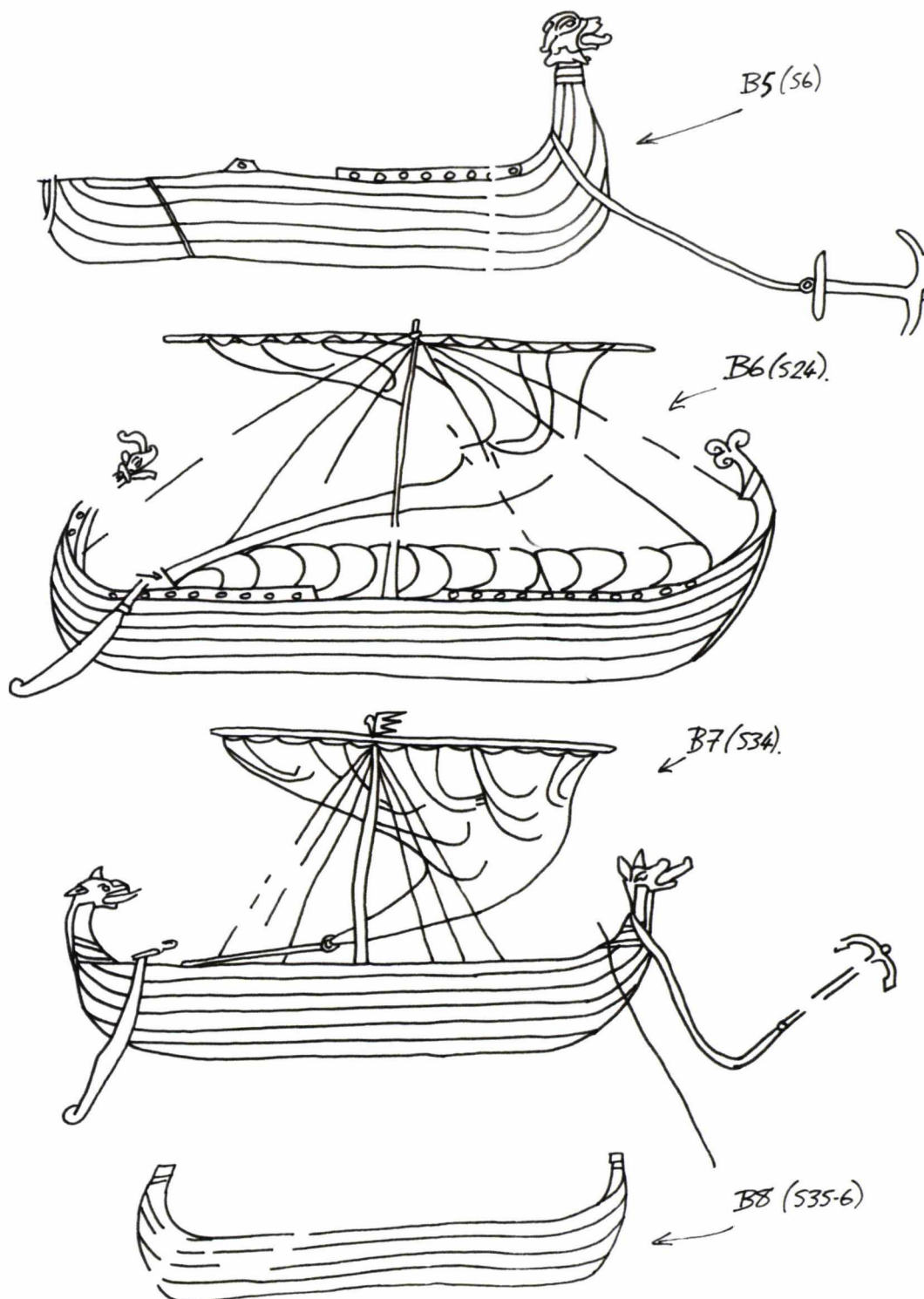
Appendix Illustration: Tapestry Buildings 29, 30, 31, 32 and 33



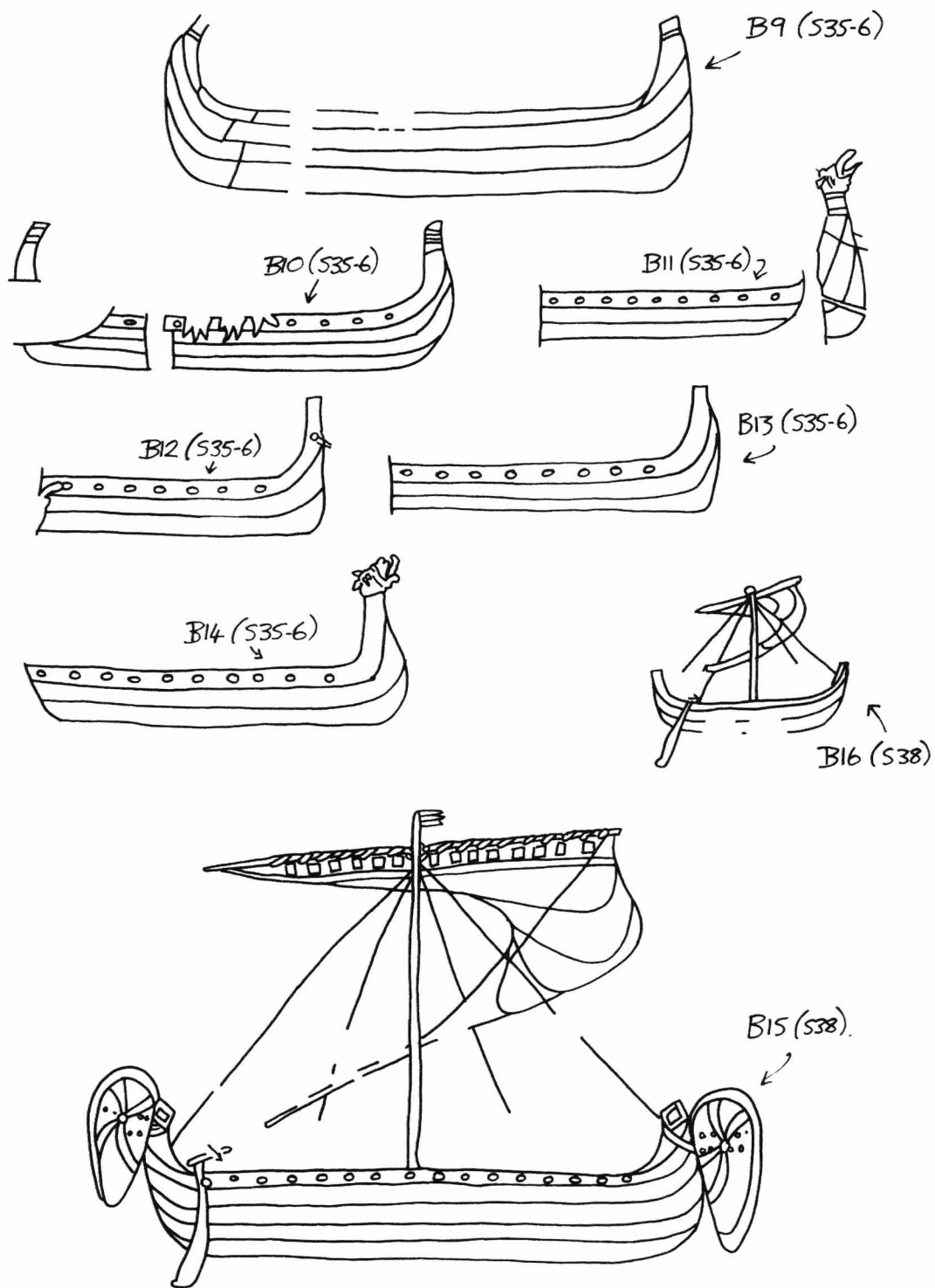
Appendix Illustration: Tapestry Ships 1, 2, 3 and 4



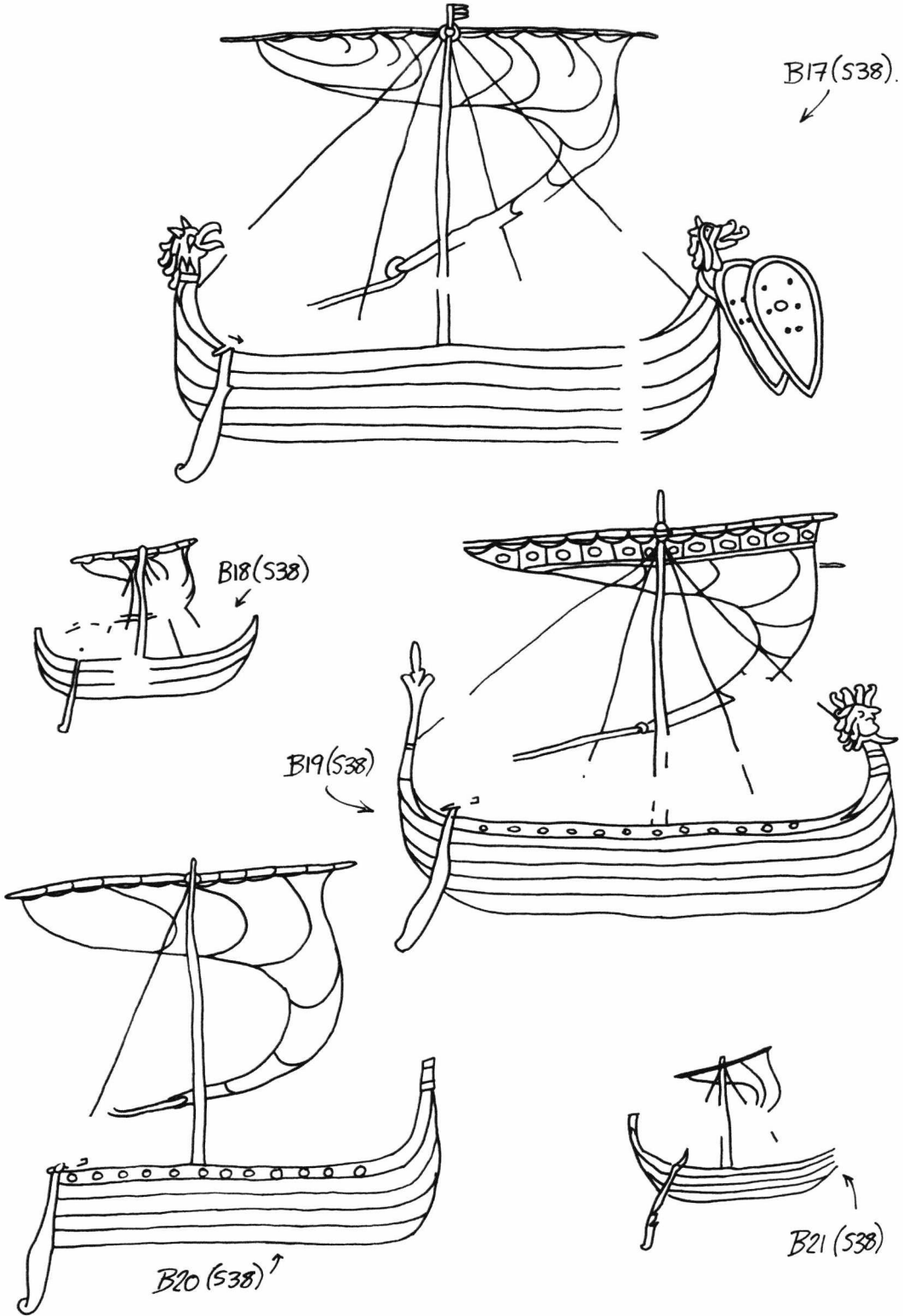
Appendix Illustration: Tapestry Ships 5, 6, 7 and 8



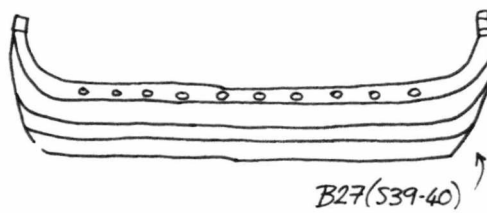
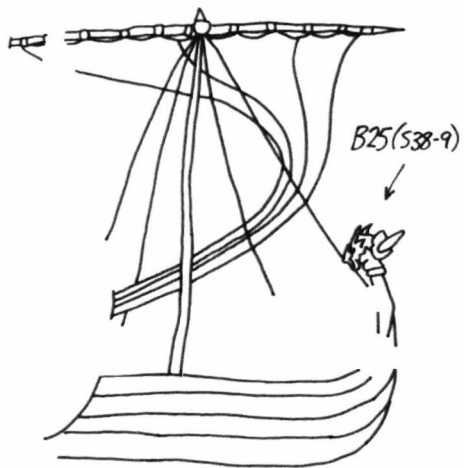
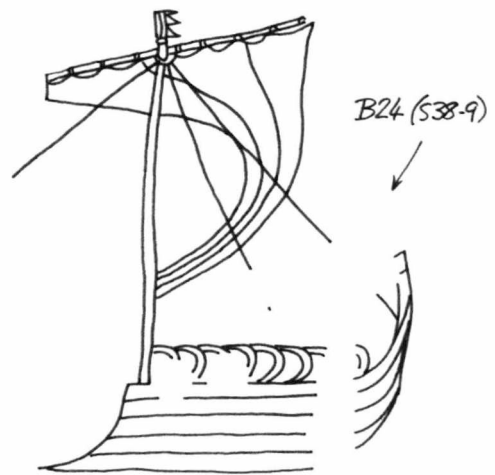
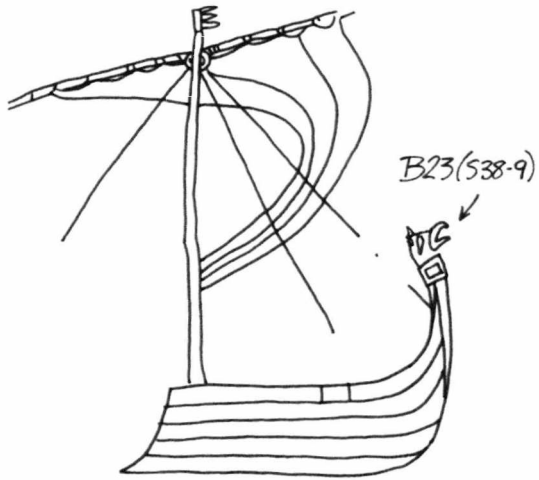
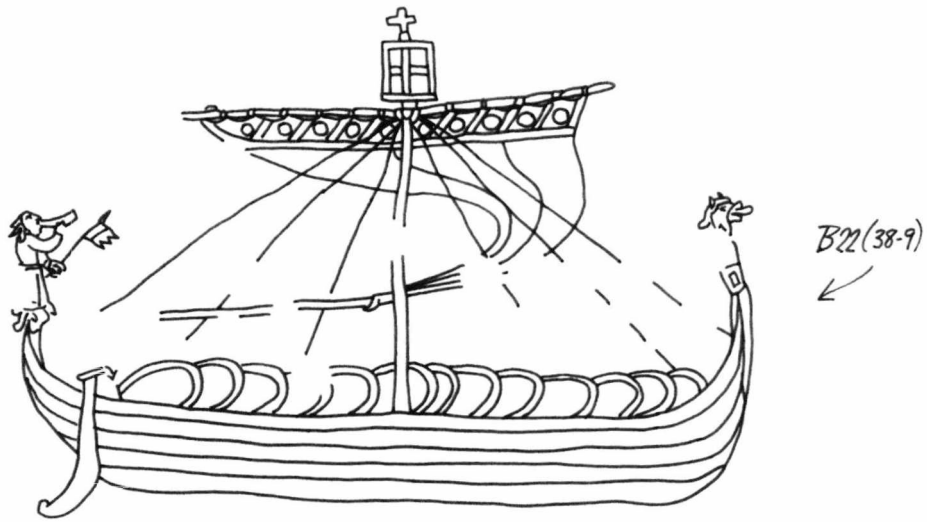
Appendix Illustration: Tapestry Ships 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15 and 16



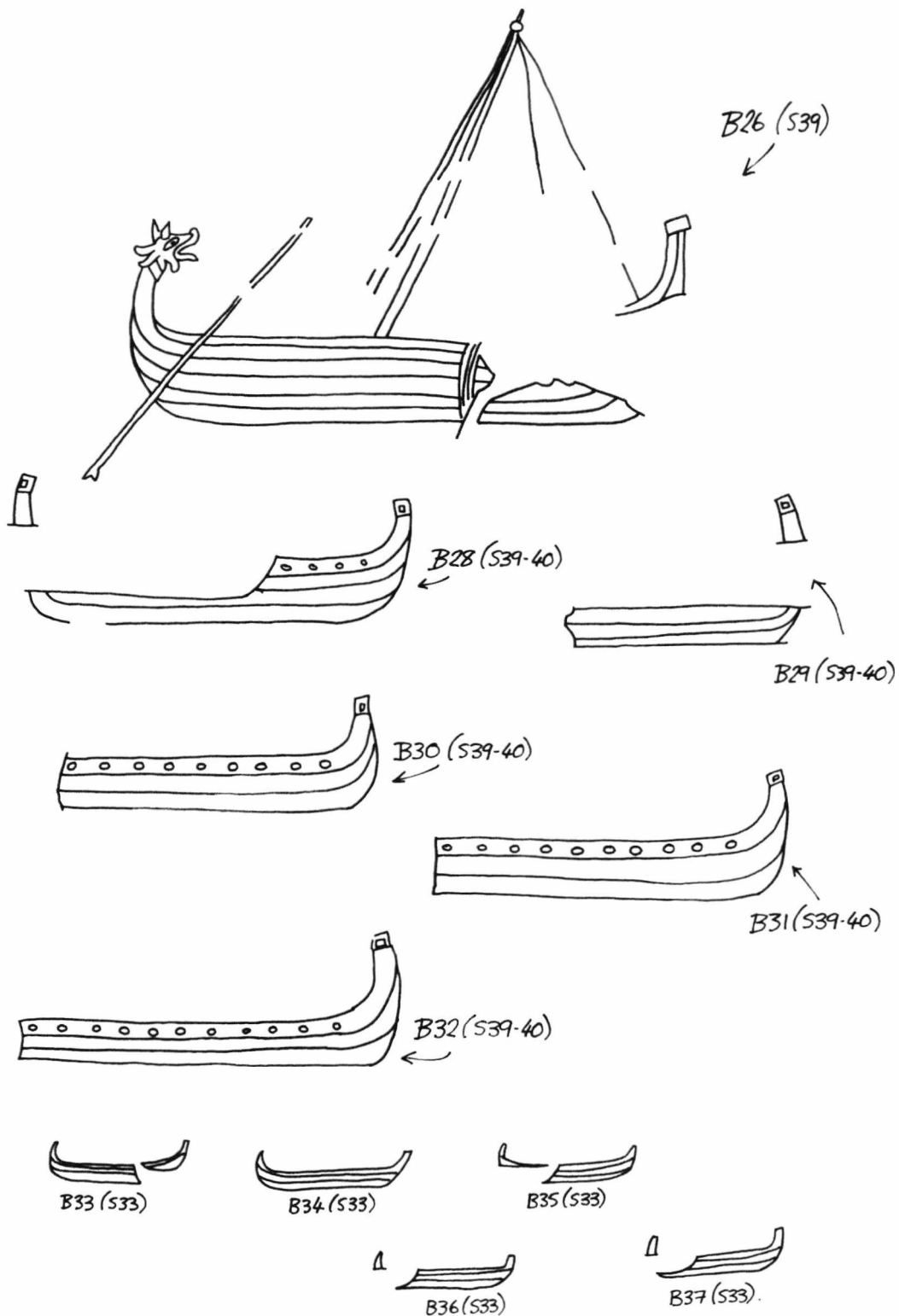
Appendix Illustration: Tapestry Ships 17, 18, 19, 20 and 21



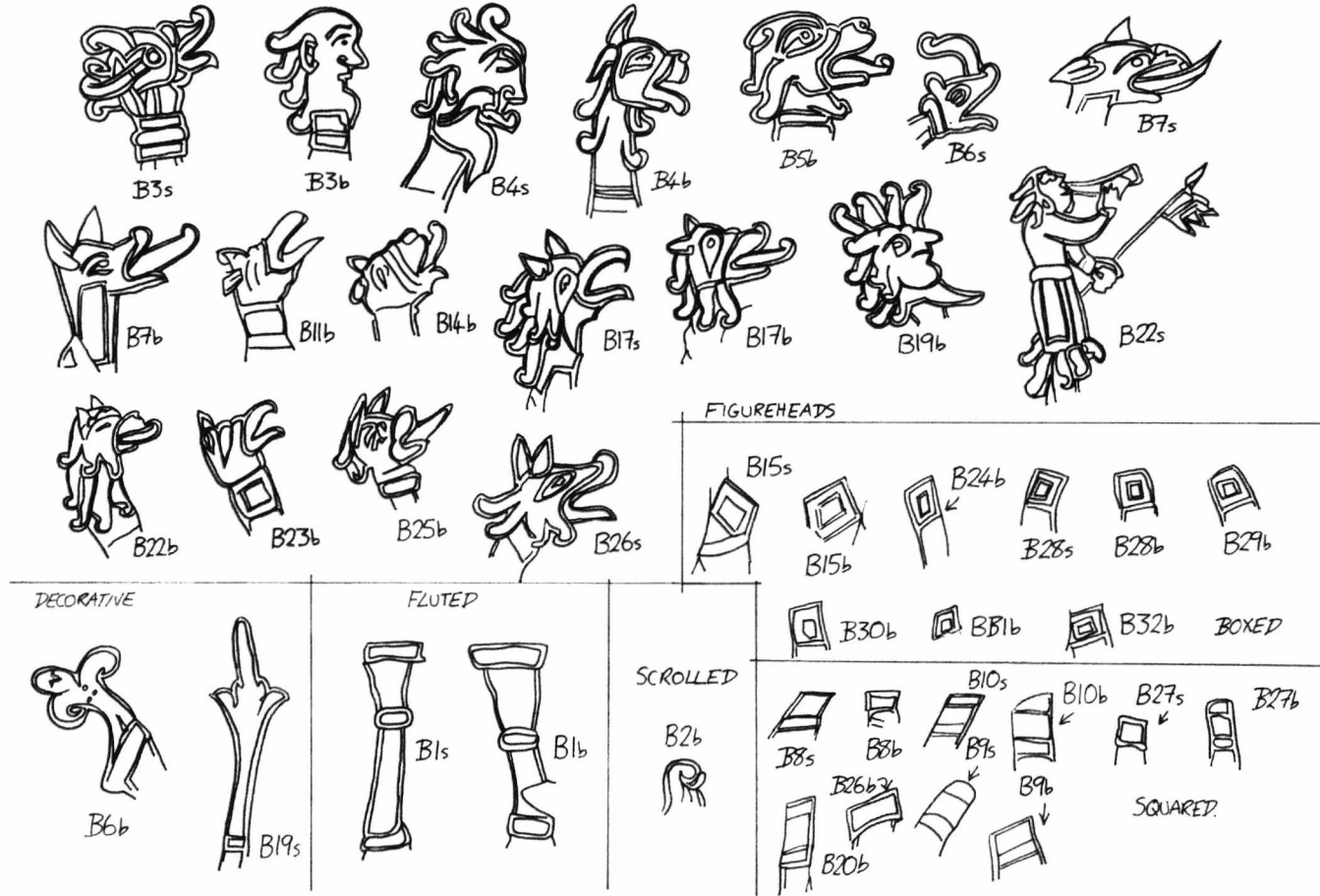
Appendix Illustration: Tapestry Ships 22, 23, 24, 25 and 27



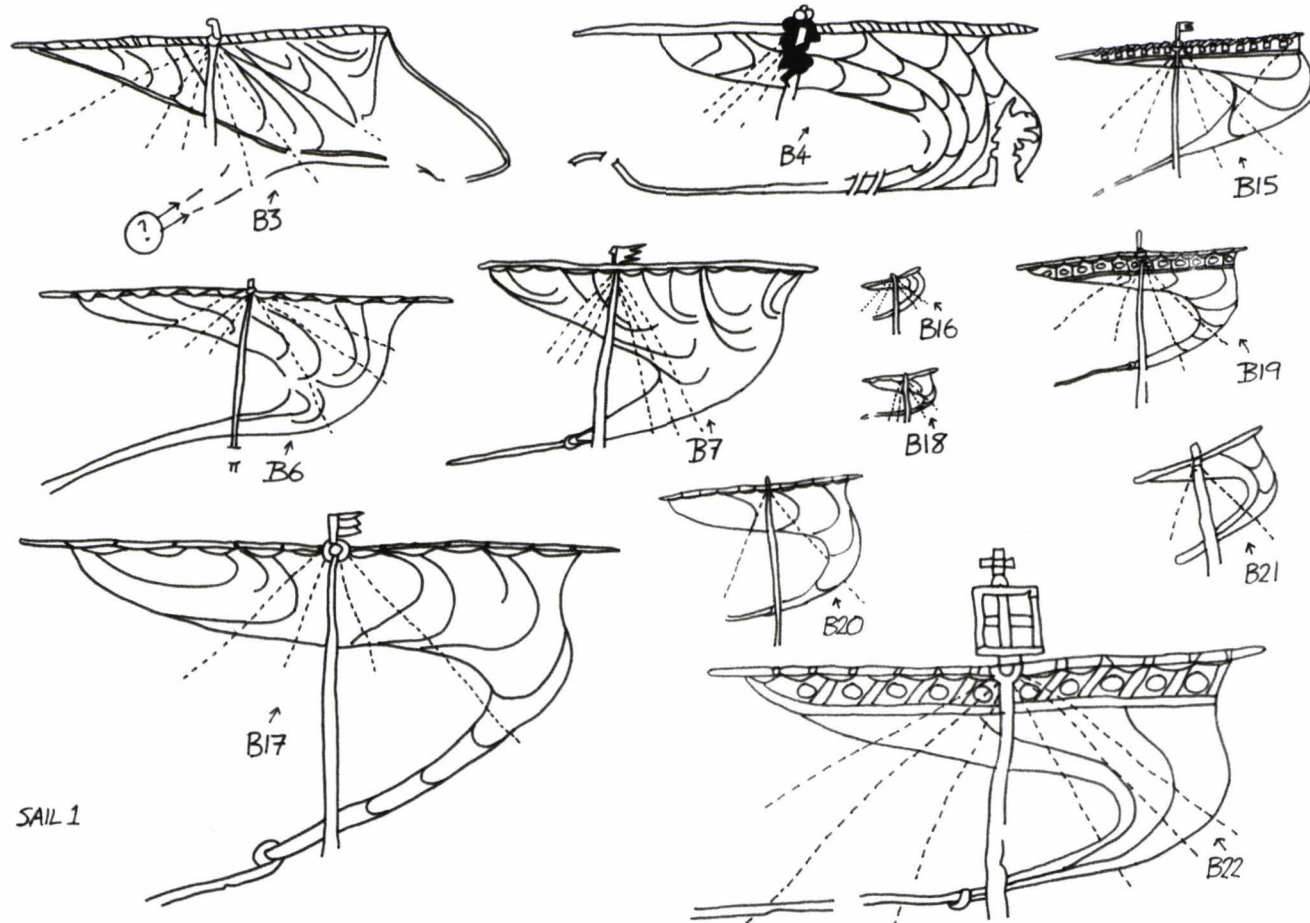
Appendix Illustration: Tapestry Ships 26, 28, 29, 30, 31, 32, 33, 34, 35, 36 and 37



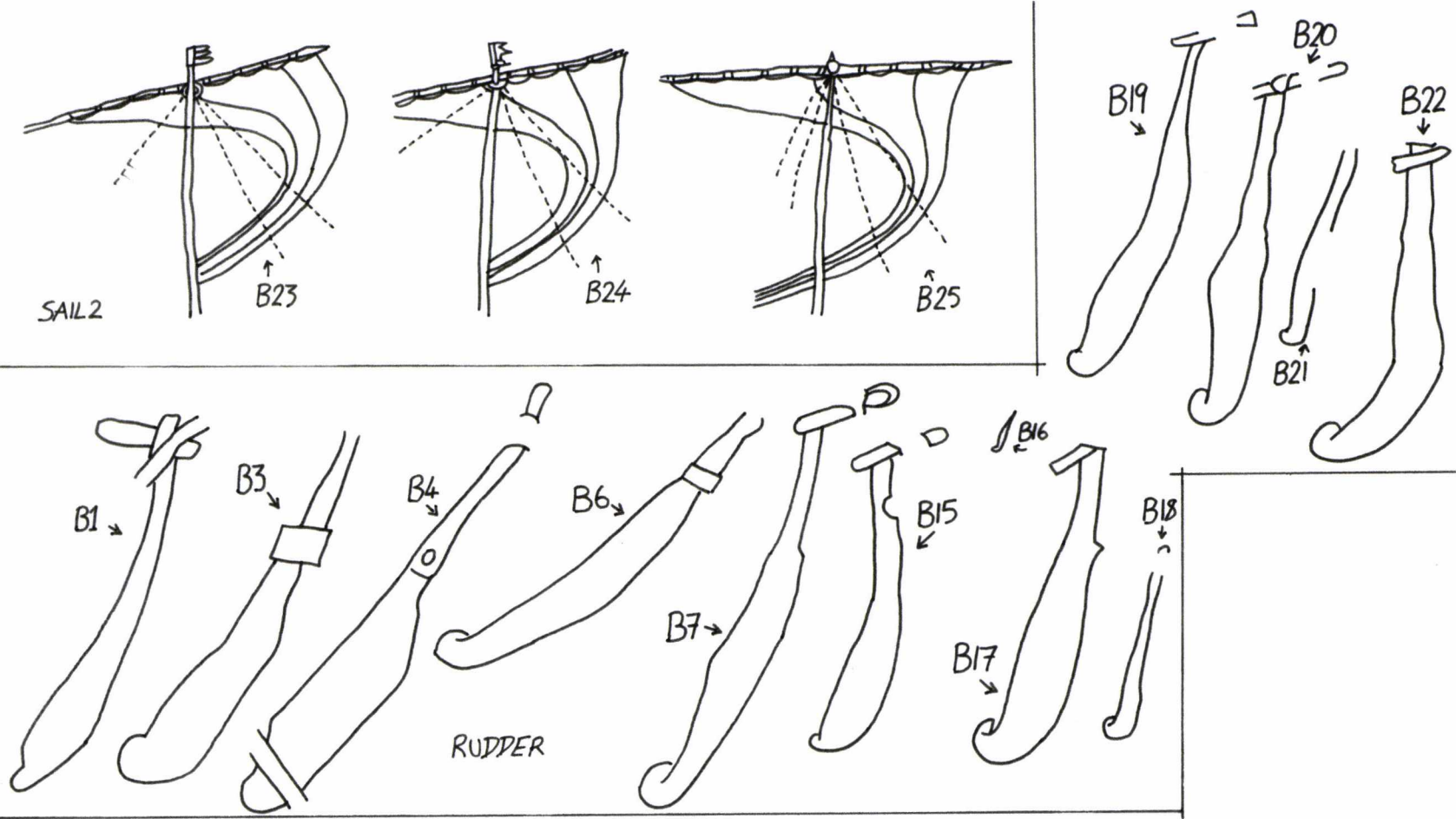
Appendix Illustration: Tapestry Ships – Stem Decoration



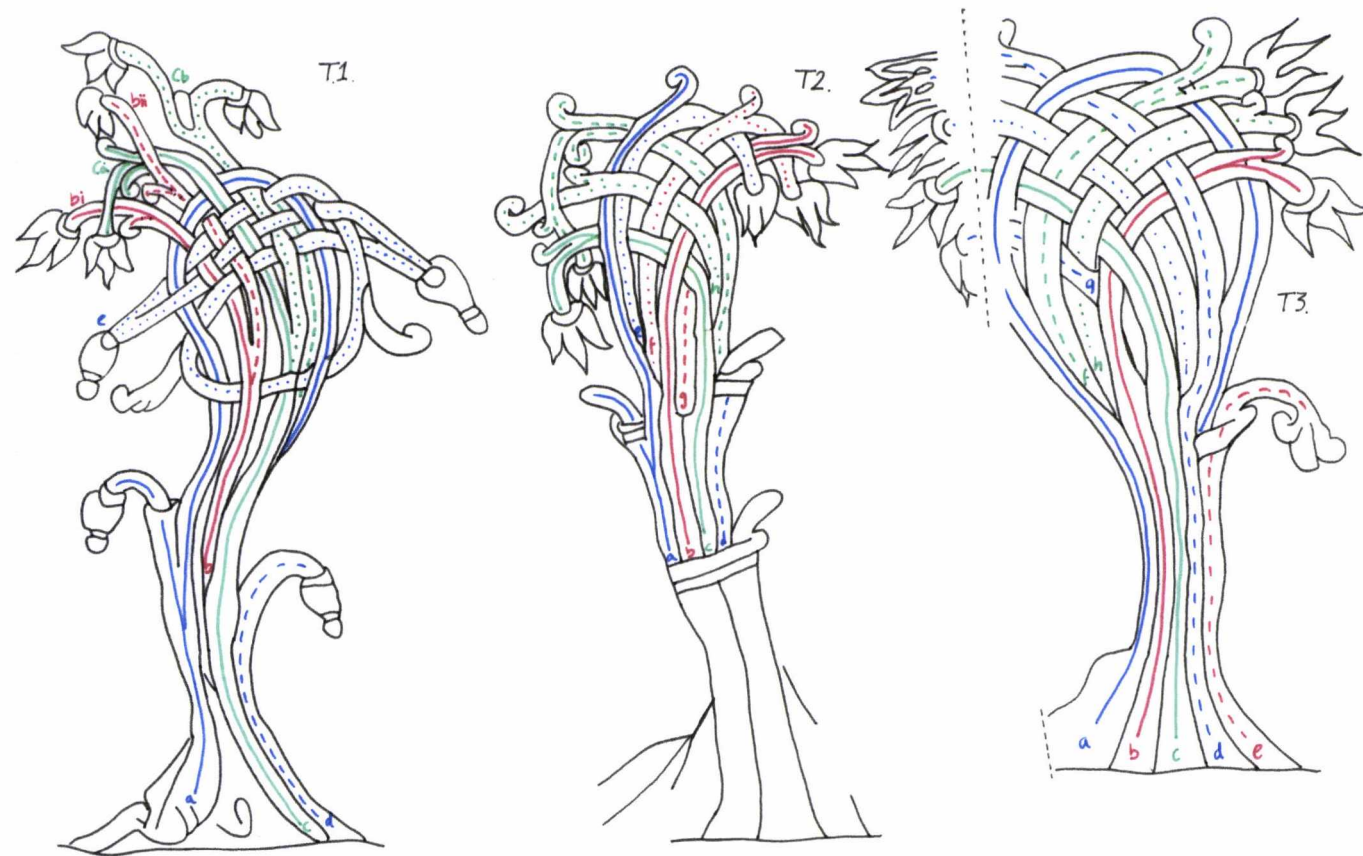
Appendix Illustration: Tapestry Ships – Sails



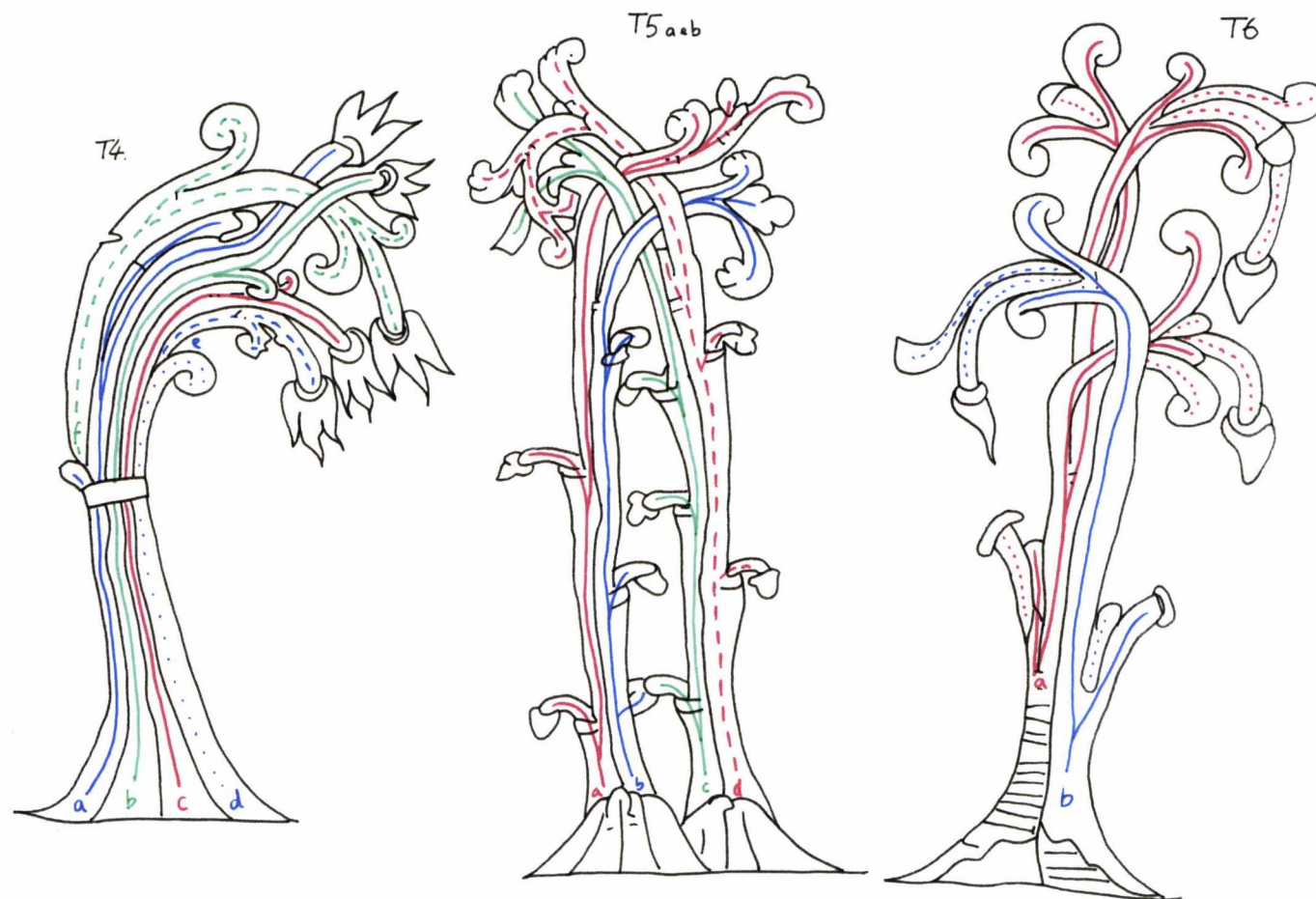

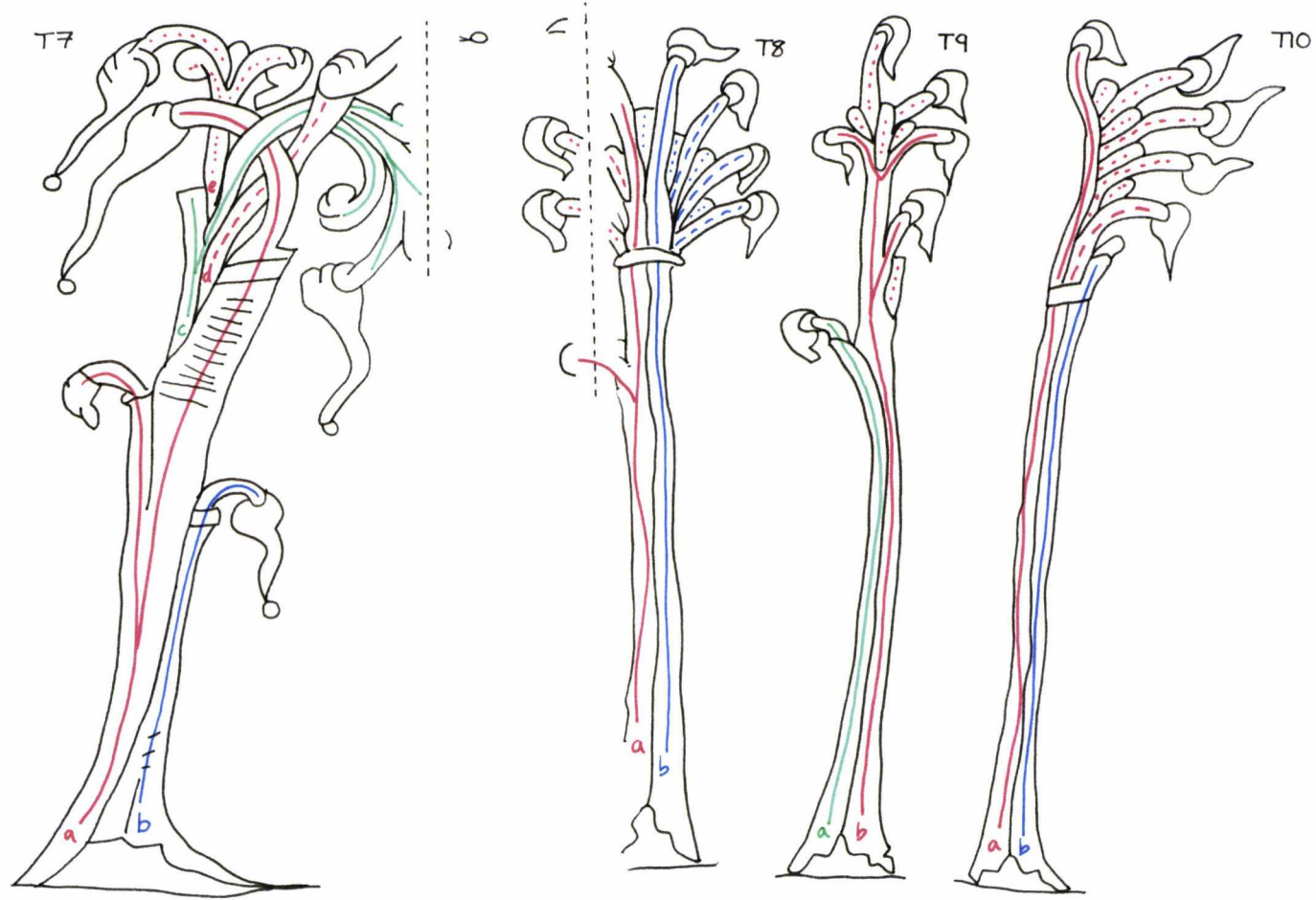

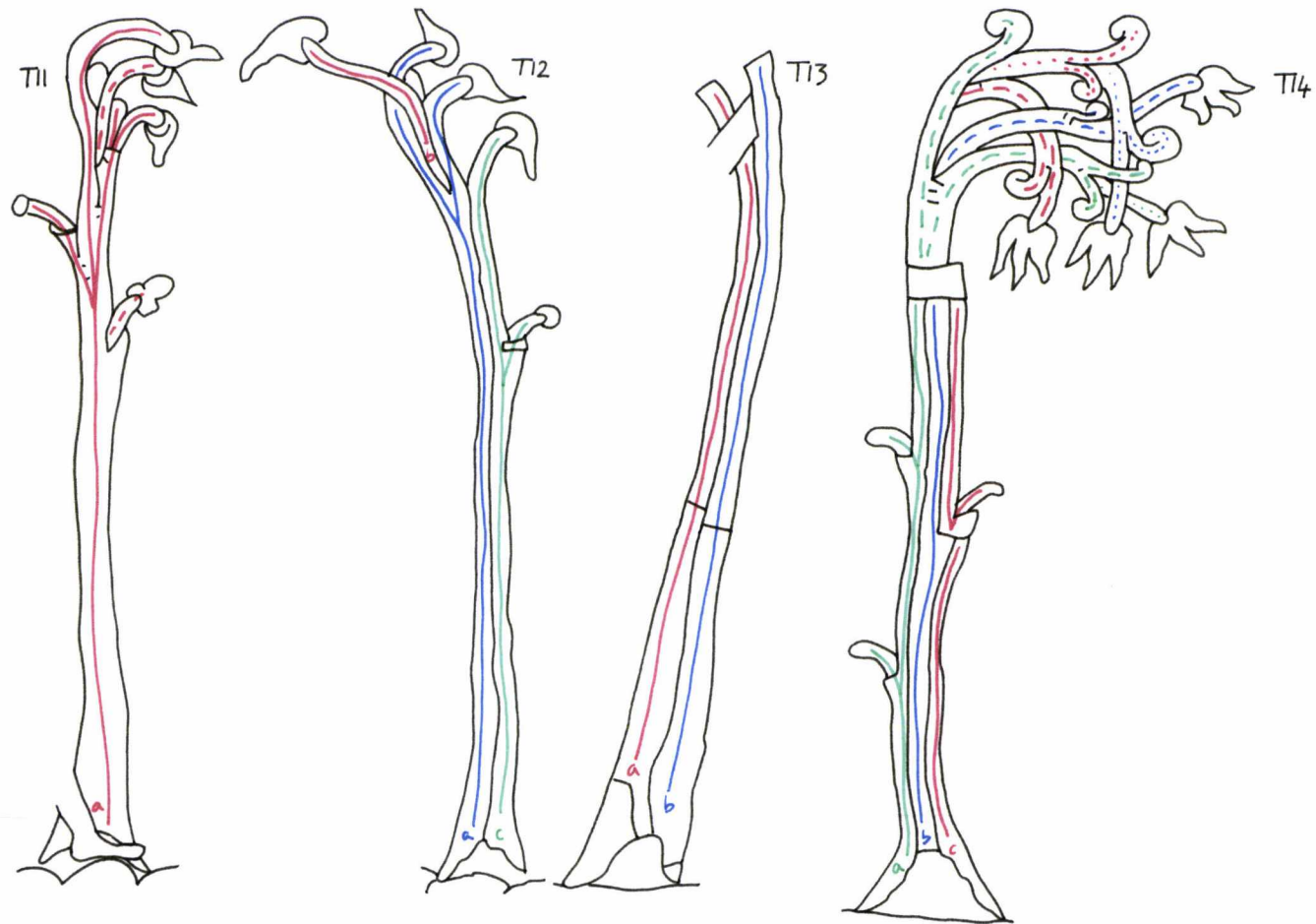

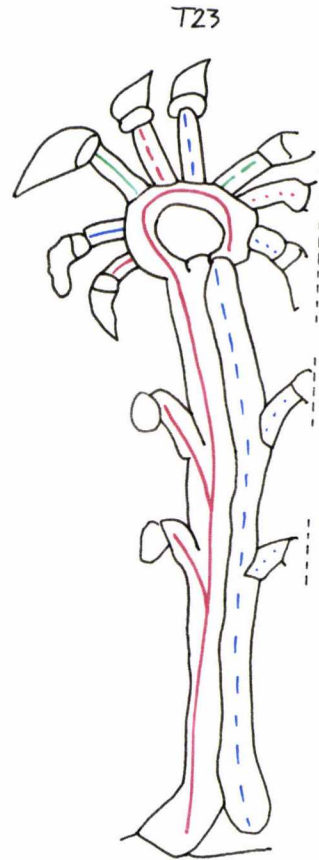
